

## **CONTENTS OF THE ENTRANCE TEST Theory and history of fine and decorative arts**

The tasks are based on theoretical material from the history and theory of fine and decorative arts. This includes individual questions of the theoretical blocks of the disciplines of fine and decorative and applied arts of the bachelor's degree, such as theory of art, history of domestic art, history of foreign art, history of decorative and applied art, interior and perspective, color science, plastic anatomy, interior and perspective. The proposed questions contain material both from the theory of art in general and from the history of foreign and domestic art in the context of the development of various artistic directions and styles, individual artistic phenomena, and the work of the most famous artists of various historical periods. Much attention is paid to domestic art, determining its place and significance in the system of world art, relationships with foreign art, etc.

#### **Testing artistic abilities**

The entrant in A4 format must offer a graphic version of the creative composition. The topic of the composition is arbitrary (at the entrant's choice).

At the same time, the student relies on knowledge of the following sections of the composition:

1. Composition as one of the professional disciplines of training an artist of decorative and applied art.
2. Composition as comparison, assembly, combination of elements into one single structure.
3. Theoretical foundations of building an artistic composition.
4. Frontal two-dimensional artistic composition.
5. Volumetric three-dimensional artistic composition.
6. Depth-spatial artistic composition.
7. Components and means of artistic composition.
8. Form as a representation (presentation) of visual material and as a format of a work.
9. Main and auxiliary lines as one of the main conditional components in creating the composition of an artistic image.
10. Color and tonal spot (primary and secondary) in an artistic composition.
