REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PRESENTATION OF ABSTRACTS IN THE CONFERENCE PROCEEDINGS

Abstracts are accepted for publication in *Ukrainian* and *English*.

The volume of the electronic version of the abstract text is 2-5 full pages of A4 format, typed in Microsoft Word as a computer file with the extension *doc, *docx. **Margins:** all page margins – 2.0 cm; alignment –width. **Text font** – Times New Roman, **size** – 14, **paragraph indentation** – 1 cm, **line spacing** – 1. Pages are not numbered.

The opinions of the authors may not coincide with the position of the editorial board. Abstracts are not reviewed. Responsibility for the accuracy of facts, quotes, own names and other information lies with the authors of the publications.

After sending (to the email address) the application, the electronic version of the abstracts, the organizing committee will notify the conference participant by email within 3 working days about the receipt and acceptance of the materials.

The organizing committee reserves the right to reject materials that do not meet the requirements and issues of the conference or were received after May 10, 2025.

The sequence of placing materials in the abstracts of the report:

- name and surname of the author (right, font bold);
- academic degree, academic title (if any);
- position;
- place of study or work (full official name);
- similar information about the research supervisor (for those who do not have an academic degree);
- across the line title of the report (in capital letters, centered, font bold);
- text of the manuscript (by width);

- the list of sources used should be provided at the end of the article after the word "**References**" in alphabetical order (size -12, spacing -1). References are given in parentheses, e.g., (Budin, 2001, p. 9).

The list of sources used should be formatted according to the international standard APA 7 (American Psychological Association Style).
